# Cookie policy

## What are cookies?

**Zambon USA Ltd.** uses cookies. Cookies are "small text files" - consisting of letters and numbers - that the websites visited by users send to their terminals (usually the browser), where they are stored for subsequent retransmission to the same websites at the time of the same user's next visit. The function of the cookies is to streamline web traffic analysis or indicate when a specific website or part of it is visited, and to distinguish between visitors in order to provide personalized content. They help administrators improve the website and the users' navigation experience.

Through cookies we cannot access other information stored on your device, even if the cookies are downloaded there. Cookies cannot upload codes of any type or carry viruses or malware, and they do not harm the user's terminal.

Afterwards, all the information installed on the cookies through this website may be found, as well as the necessary instructions for managing your preferences on the matter.

## User Consent

A summary disclosure regarding the use of cookies will appear the first time a user connects to any page of the website. By closing this disclosure with the special button, the user agrees to our use of the cookies, as described in this Cookie Policy.

The website remembers the choice made by the user, and therefore the brief disclosure will not be shown again during subsequent connections by the same device. However, the user will always have the option of revoking the consent previously given in whole or in part.

## What kind of cookies do we use?

The use of cookies by this website owner, Zambon USA Ltd., One Broadway, 14th Floor, Cambridge, MA 02142, is included in the Privacy Policy available [here](#).

In order to allow our website to be used and our services to be provided, we use both the so-called persistent cookies (that is, cookies that remain in the memory until they are manually eliminated by the user or for which a long-term scheduled removal is provided) and the so-called session cookies, which are not stored persistently in the visitor's computer and disappear when the browser is closed.

We use cookies of different types - with specific functions - that can be classified as follows:

### FIRST PARTY COOKIES, I.E., ISSUED BY ZAMBON

#### COOKIE TYPE

Technical/session;

Technical/navigation.

### **WHAT DO THEY DO?**

These cookies are essential for the correct operation of our website and allow the user to navigate and view the content. Any deactivation would lead to website malfunctions.

In general, they are required to keep a navigation session open or to allow a user accessing any reserved areas. They can also temporarily remember text inserted while filling out a form, or when returning to a previous page during the same session.

### **COOKIE TYPE**

Technical/functionality

### **WHAT DO THEY DO?**

These cookies allow the user to take full advantage of the website's features and enjoy a more comfortable navigation. The website works best if these cookies are enabled; however, it is possible to decide not to allow their activation on your device.

As an example, cookies of this type remember the language in which the user prefers to view our content.

### **WHAT DO THEY DO?**

These cookies keep track of the consent given by the user for using cookies on this website, in order not to repeat - at subsequent visits - the brief disclosure on cookies and the request for consent.

## **THIRD PARTY COOKIES, THAT IS, ISSUED BY WEBSITES OTHER THAN ZAMBON**

### **COOKIE TYPE**

Statistical/analytics

### **WHAT DO THEY DO?**

They are used to collect information on user navigation modes on our website. This information is analyzed in aggregated form solely for statistical purposes. They are not necessary, but they are very helpful in allowing us to improve our content and our services based on the indications we obtain from analyzing the statistics.

### **Third party cookies**

When you navigate this website you will receive cookies both from Zambon USA Ltd. and cookies from third-party websites, which may set cookies on your device on our behalf in order to deliver the services they provide.

Third-party cookies allow us to obtain more complete surveys of user exploration habits. We use these cookies, for example, to compile statistics on the use of our website and to evaluate your

interest in specific content or services. More detailed information on these cookies is available in this document and on the respective websites of the third parties in question.

### **Statistical cookies (third party)**

This website uses Google Analytics, a web traffic analysis service provided by Google, Inc. that uses cookies to collect and analyze information on user navigation in aggregated form. Neither Zambon USA Ltd. nor Google associate your IP address and other data in their possession to identify you directly.

The collected information is processed by the Google Analytics systems to produce reports for the administrators of Zambon USA Ltd., who use them to verify the correct operation of the services and possibly the popularity rating of the proposed content.

### **How to set your terminal**

If users do not agree with cookie installation, they must configure the browser to disable cookies reception or not use this website. However, if cookies are disabled, the website or some of its functions may not operate correctly.

In order to change the way the cookies are used, block their reception or delete cookies found on your terminal, simply enter your own browser's settings.

Most browsers provide the option of accepting or rejecting all cookies or of accepting only some (for example, from specific websites).
